



## INSTRUCTIONS TO ACCESS TO THE GLACIOS

- 1) Contact with Pablo Guerra (Head of the cryoEM platform) by email ([pglcri@ibmb.csic.es](mailto:pglcri@ibmb.csic.es)) to schedule your microscope session. Depending of the previous sample information, one type of session or another will be assigned.
- 2) Complete the experiment information form (download from [this link](#)) and send it to [pglcri@ibmb.csic.es](mailto:pglcri@ibmb.csic.es). This form is available in this [platform webpage](#) too.
